

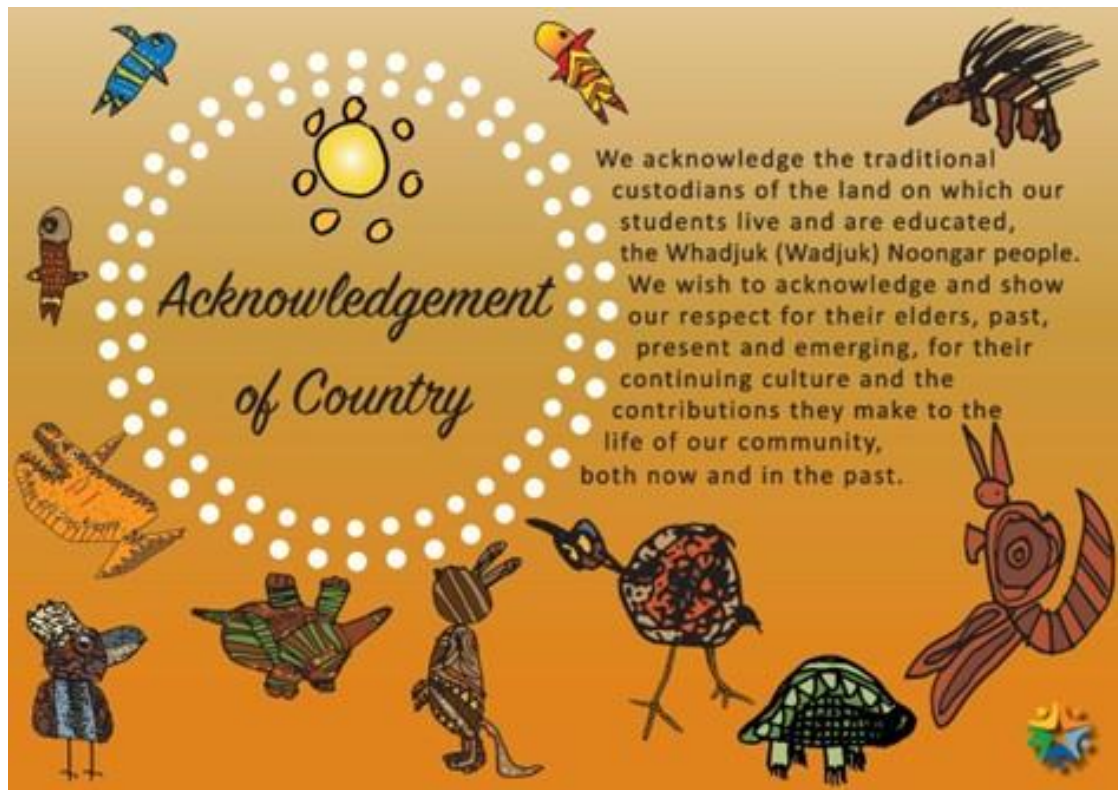
LIWARA CATHOLIC PRIMARY SCHOOL ATHLETICS CARNIVAL

Year 3-6 Champion Boy & Girl

The champion, runner-up and 3rd place boy and girl students in Year 3-6 will be determined based on results from the following events.

Long Jump, Shot Put, Turbo Javelin, 100m, 200m and 400m

Students are awarded points on a sliding scale for each event.

1st place = 20 points, 2nd place = 14 points, 3rd place = 10 points,

4th place = 6 points, 5th place = 4 points, 6th place = 2 points.

All other participants will receive 1 point towards their faction.

*Please note that due to the 200m running races needing to be split into smaller heats, the results will be based on overall times rather than places to determine the points.

Interschool Athletics Carnival

Following the Athletics Carnival, students from Year 3-6 will be selected to represent the school at the Interschool Athletics Carnival which takes place in Week 2 of Term 4.

The top six boy and girl competitors from each year group will compete in the 100m and 200m races.

The top three will be selected for the 400m races.

The top two will be selected for Long Jump, Shot Put & Turbo Javelin events.
